Research Before You Buy: Check the reputation of unfamiliar websites. Read reviews and ensure they have secure payment options.

Shop Small and Local: Support local businesses during Small Business Saturday. It's a safer way to shop while boosting your community.

Get Ahead on Financial Aid: Submit Your FAFSA for 2025

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is your key to unlocking financial aid for college. Whether you're applying for grants, scholarships, work-study, or loans, completing the FAFSA is the first step to ensure you get the assistance you need.

The 2025-2026 FAFSA form will be available **on or before December 1, 2024,** and it's important to apply as early as possible to maximize your financial aid options.

Helpful Tips for Submitting Your FAFSA:

- **Gather Required Documents:** You'll need your Social Security number, tax returns, and other financial information. If you're a dependent, you'll also need your parents' financial details.
- Create an FSA ID: This is required to electronically sign your FAFSA and access your information. Both students and parents need their own FSA ID.
- Check for Errors: Even small mistakes can delay your application, so double-check all your information before submitting.
